

Dear Supplier,

The United Kingdom recently enacted a new regulation, effective 30th September 2023, requiring importers of certain articles of iron and steel processed in third countries to provide evidence of the country of origin of the iron and steel inputs used for the processing of the products.

Furthermore, on 8th September 2023 the UK government published guidance regarding documentation needed to demonstrate compliance.

The UK will require documentation to evidence:

- the country of origin of the iron and steel products processed in the third country (or third countries) after the fact.
- the date the iron and steel product left its country of origin.
- the country(s) and facility(s) where processing has taken place.

An example of evidence may include, but is not limited to, a Mill Test Certificate (MTC), or Mill Test Certificates (MTCs) where the relevant information cannot be summarised in a single document.

The requirement took effect for imports into the United Kingdom starting 30th September 2023.

For all shipments scheduled to arrive for import into the UK on or after September 20, the supplier must include the appropriate evidence in the shipping documentation when shipping the affected parts to HT Brigham & Company Ltd.
